Admissions Policy for Brookham Nursery and Reception

NURSERY

The Nursery class is known as Bear Cubs and is made up of Little Bears and Big Bears. Big Bears (children who are 3 years old by 1st September) normally attend a minimum of three sessions a week, which may be taken as full days or as half days. Extra sessions may be added on as an option as the year progresses. Some of the older Big Bears attend full days immediately. Little Bears (from 2 years old) are offered up to 5 morning sessions.

During the morning sessions each week, there will be Music, Spanish, PE and Forest School. Furthermore, Big Bears will have a swimming lesson in the school pool. All of these areas will be taught by specialist teachers with the support of the nursery staff.

If nursery children stay for the afternoon, the children have the opportunity to learn inside and outside through well planned activities and child initiated play.

- Morning sessions (Little Bears and Big Bears) : 8.15am – 11.45am
- Mornings including lunch (Little Bears and Big Bears) : 8.15am – 1.00pm

- Afternoon sessions (Big Bears only) : 12.15pm – 3.15pm
- Full days (Big Bears only) : 8.15am – 3.15pm

Parents will be liable for fees according to the schools standard fee schedule (as attached). Priority for space in the afternoons will be given to those who are attending full days.

RECEPTION

The reception classes are for children who are four years old on 1st September. Though Reception is fulltime, we offer Friday afternoons as a flexible session, as some of the children are very tired by the end of the week. As in Nursery, each week Reception children are taught by specialist teachers for Music, Spanish, PE and Forest School. They also have a weekly swimming lesson in the school pool.

Reception fees are as per the attached fee schedule.
